On the first Tuesday of August the citizen's of Evans will celebrate National Night Out. The Evans Police Department encourages you and your neighbors to use this event to let criminals know you will not tolerate any criminal activity in your neighborhood. This year National Night Out is on August 3rd. Events can be held during any part of the day although traditionally the events are in the evening. Take a stand against crime and drugs by coming together with your neighbors, get to know each other for the sake of knowing who belongs in your neighborhood, recognizing your neighbors and making a unified statement that you will watch out for each other. Neighbors who are united in watching for and reporting suspicious activity have safer neighborhoods to live in.

If you would like to take part in this event you can register at the Evans Police Department by contacting Officer Lisa Duffy. It is not necessary to register every house taking part in the activities but rather just the block having the event. Remember National Night Out events can be as simple or elaborate as you want. Activities range from root beer floats, lemonade stands, pot luck barbeques, entertainment bands to scavenger hunts.
